

 - The second survey (2008/10~11) Cataloguing and digitization of 86 books



6 The Museum Fine of Arts, Boston

- □ There are many works produced in Edo after Bunsei era(1822 ~)
 Utagawa school
 Toyokuni , Kunisada , KUniyoshi, Kunitora
- □ Kunisada(false name:Bukiyo Matahei Bukiyo Matahei)
 collection has 32 Kunisada's works
 (include reprinted books with new title and quetionable works)
 Hayashi listed 66 works, Shirakura listed 42 works.

Kunisada's first shunpon: *Hyakki yagyo*(1825) representative works: *Enshi gojuyojo*(1835) *Azuma genji*(1837)
