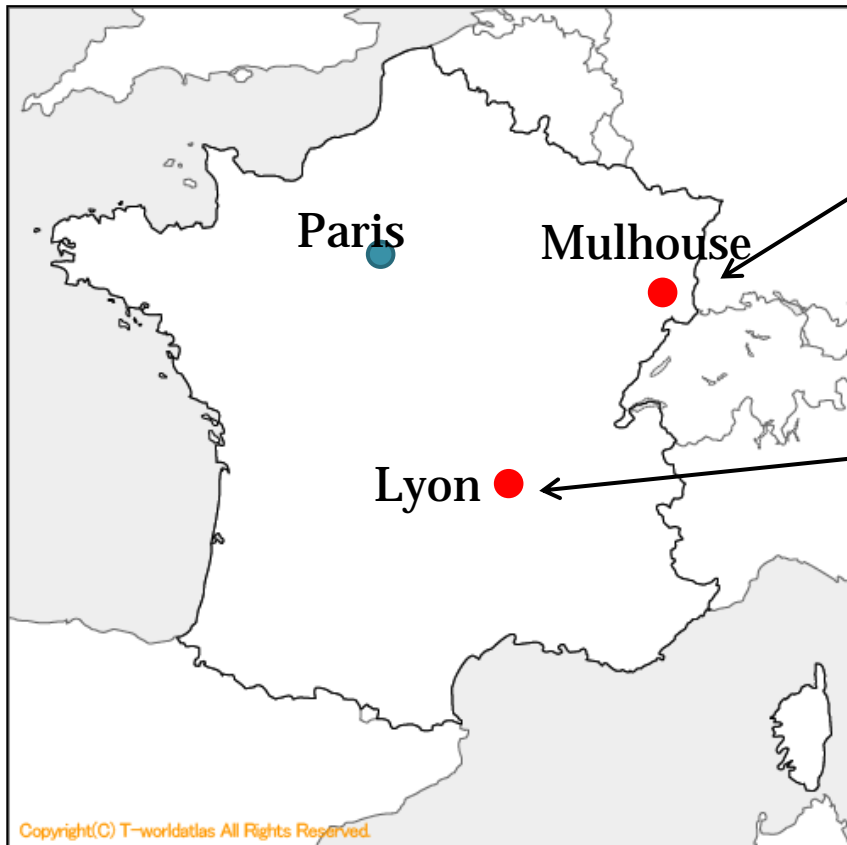

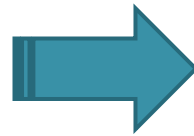
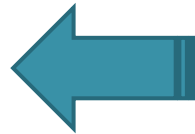

(A) Le Musée de l'Impression sur Etoffes de Mulhouse (The Museum of Printed Textiles of Mulhouse)



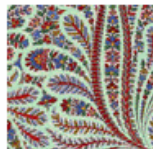
In 1746, four young men from Mulhouse founded the city's first textile printing works.

G.Cambefort & Cie (13 Rue du Garet)
* the agency for Takashimaya in Lyon



1905 Finishes its contract with G. Cambefort & Cie and opens a new shop at 15 Rue du Garet.

1913 Takashimaya fusions its Lyon and London branches, leaving only the London office open.
