The TCSOL/TESOL Summer Dual Certificate Program in Japan is a collaborative program co-sponsored by the Center for International Foreign Language Teacher Education (CIFLTE) at Teachers College, Columbia University and Osaka Gakuin University (OGU). Developed and taught by Columbia professors, this three-week program implements a cutting-edge curriculum that sets trainees on an efficient track to receive state-of-the-art training in the Teaching of Chinese and/or English as a foreign language. Trainees have the option of obtaining a single certificate in TCSOL (Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages), TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages), or a dual certificate in both.
