# <u>Kinugasa BBP Management Staff</u> 2018 Spring Term Application Guidelines

In April 2018, a new space for learning, Beyond Borders Plaza (hereafter BBP) will open at the Kinugasa, Biwako-Kusatsu and Osaka Ibaraki campuses for the purpose of language study and international interchange. At BBP, various forms of support and planning for the provision of foreign language study materials, the carrying out of consultations regarding study abroad, interchange events for Japanese and international students amongst others will be developed. We are recruiting student management staff that will support the users of this new facility as well as further enhance the internationalization on Kinugasa campus.

# [Activity Details]

- 1. Advertising and coordination of international exchange and other events held solely or jointly by BBP
- 2. Reception of BBP users, guidance regarding usage of the facility, surveying of the facility usage situation and processing of usage statistics
- 3. Updating of SNS etc. and management operations for the specially established BBP website
- 4. Other duties as instructed by the BBP steering committee

# [Activity Conditions]

- Term of duty···(Mon) April 2, 2018 to (Wed) August 1, 2018
  - \*We plan to carry out prior (paid) training sometime before the start of duties.
- Place of work···Activities will revolve mainly around BBP (Kinugasa campus, Current Language Center).
- Hours of work…In principle, shift work within the frame set between 10:00 to 18:00 from Monday to Friday during the term of classes.

#### [Pay]

- 909 yen per hour
- \*Transportation costs will not be paid.

#### [Number of candidates sought]

Approximately 15 persons

#### (Application conditions)

- Persons who are interested in international interchange and the internationalization of the university, and can participate with enthusiasm in the activities at BBP.
- Students belonging to a college or graduate school on Kinugasa campus who can do shift work on 2 days a week or more. Foreign nationals who are international regular students can also apply.

- [Japanese students] An ability to hold an everyday conversation in English is desirable.
- [International students] An ability to hold an everyday conversation in Japanese is desirable.
  - \* International students must submit a copy of their "Residence Card/Permission to Engage in Activity Other than that Permitted under the Status of Residence Previously Granted" at the time they are hired.
- · Ability to participate in the prior training (Planned to be held in March 2018)
