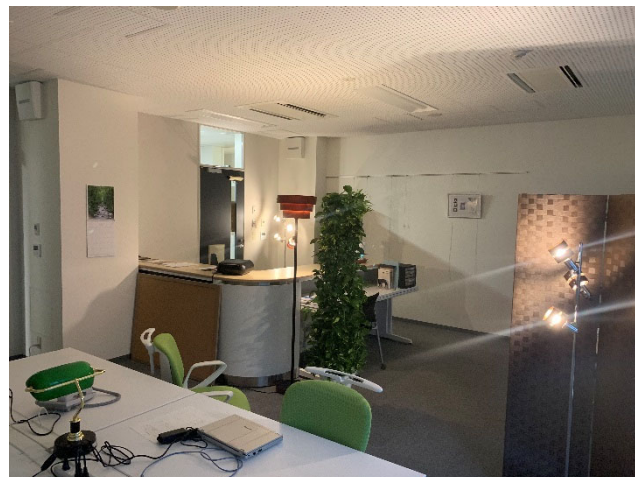


GLA Academic Advising Center (AAC)
