Students are currently being sought to join the BBP Project Team for the 2021 Spring Semester. The BBP Project Team is a volunteer student group which operates out of the Beyond Borders Plaza (BBP), a student commons where students from various backgrounds and countries come to meet and learn together.

We look forward to applicants who are eager and willing to plan and execute events and activities to meet the desire of the many Ritsumeikan University students who wish to use and improve their language skills, to meet diverse peoples, to learn more about and go on study abroad, and to challenge themselves in their student lives. This is a great opportunity for those of you who are interested in working with students outside of your department, especially with other Japanese students on campus.

1. Mission

- (1) Spreading the word about the BBP among students and creating a more easy-to-enter, student-friendly space.
- (2) Conceiving and carrying out events which encourage communication and learning between students of different nationalities and languages.
- (3) Conceiving and carrying out events and activities which meet the needs of students whose interests are in a certain theme or activity, such as study abroad or improving their language skills.

2. Guidelines for Events/Activities to be Carried Out by the Project Team

- (1) Duration for holding events...(Thu) Apr 1, 2021 to (Sat) Sep 25, 2021
 Planning/preparation/execution of events, to be held for the most part during lunch time or otherwise generally outside of class hours, approx. once to twice a month.
- (2) Location…Activities are to be held mainly in and around the BBP (BKC Central Arc, 2nd Fl)
 *In order to prevent the spread of the Novel Coronavirus, student entry to the campuses still may be restricted at the time of Spring Semester. We may ask students to use online communication tools such as ZOOM for BBP Activities. We appreciate your understanding in advance.

3. Number of Candidates Sought

Approximately 15 students

4. Application Criteria

- (1) Persons who are interested in international exchange and the internationalization of the university, who can enthusiastically participate in BBP activities.
- (2) Regular students belonging to a college or graduate school at BKC who are in their second or later semester at Ritsumeikan as of the 2021 Spring Semester. All nationalities are welcome.
- (3) [Japanese language based students] The ability to hold an everyday conversation in English is desirable.

- (4) [English language based students] The ability to hold an everyday conversation in Japanese is desirable.
- (5) Must be able to participate in the BKC BBP Project Team start-up training if selected as a Project Team member (planned to be held on Mon, Mar 29th, 2021).

their university email address and notified about their interview schedule on Fri, Jan 8, 2021.
