At Ritsumeikan University, we have been coordinating a student exchange with Sookmyung Women's University since the 2004 academic year. Also, Sookmyung students come to study at Ritsumeikan University through a dual degree program.

科目名(クラス) / Course Title, Class Korean Politics and Foreign Policy担当者 / Instructor Jung-In Jo**授業の概要 / Course Outline**

The purpose of this course is to use the politics of the Korean Peninsula as a testing ground for contending theories of comparative politics and international relations while presenting an analytical overview of Korean politics.

到達目標 / Attainment Objectives

This course has three goals: (1) to introduce students to salient issues in Korean and international politics; (2) to situate current events within a historical context, and (3) to provide students with analytic tools to analyze contemporary issues. We begin with an examination of the historical development of Korean politics, political economy of rapid industrialization and financial crisis, globalization, democratic transition & consolidation, political culture, political institutions, anti-Americanism, and North Korean nuclear issue. We will then consider the prospects for a "liberal peace" in the region, made possible through increasing economic interdependence and through democratization. The course ends with a discussion of future prospect toward the East Asian region.

授業の概要 / Course Outline

This course is a continuing intermediate Korean class for students who are already experienced in learning Korean. The course is conducted mostly in Korean, and students interact in Korean with their classmates under a teacher's guide. They also receive exposure to the language via a variety of authentic sources such as the Internet, audio, video and printed materials which help them develop cultural awareness as well as linguistic proficiency. This course directly supports communicative competence with Korean in four areas of language skills, speaking, listening, reading and writing in the high intermediate level. Also, this course designed to prepare for Korean as an academic purpose in the area of reading and writing using academic vocabulary.

到達目標 / Attainment Objectives

The objective of this course is to develop:

- ・ High intermediate conversational abilities of Korean (pronunciation, fundamental grammatical patterns, common vocabulary, and standard usage)
- ・ High intermediate reading and writing skills in Korean
- ・ Knowledge of academic vocabulary
