### 1 . Important Notice

(1) Please remember to bring your student ID and a black pen. Your student ID will be stamped with a seal certifying that you have completed the Health Check.

Please read also the other side.

(2) Urine Sample

Please bring the sample you took in the morning of the Health Check. If you forget the sample, please tell staff about it and you can take the sample there and then. If you cannot take the sample on that day, we let you know the date that you bring it later on. In that case, we collect the container distributed beforehand so please bring it at the Health Check.

(3) Fourth year/above Undergraduate students and second year/above Graduate students (including Doctorate students) are required to have a visual-exam. Therefore, please make sure to bring your glasses or contact lenses.

(4) As a chest X-rays will be taken, please make sure you wear clothes that are easy to remove, and please remove any accessories beforehand. Make sure to prepare a thin, plain t-shirt with no lace or designs.

(5) If you are not able to attend on the above specified date due to classes or other unavoidable circumstances, please take the Health Check on one of the other dates listed above. However, you may not take the Health Check on the same day as first year students. Also, as April 15<sup>th</sup>, the last day for Health Checks, will be very crowded, please make sure you come before April 14<sup>th</sup> to take your Health Check.

(6) Mature students who have had a Health Check through their place of work from April of 2011 must provide a copy of the results to the Medical Service Center (first floor of the Shigakukan) after the Health Check period, but before the end of April 2012. This will be counted as a completed Health Check. However, if you have not had a Health Check for over 1 year, you must take one at this time. If you are scheduled to have a Health Check at your place of work in the near future, please consult with the Medical Service Center.

(7) Students who belong to an athletic club are required to take the Athletic Clubs Health Check at the same time as the regular Health Check.

(8) Students who admitted in autumn in 2011 term also need to undergo the Health Check.

(9) If you have any questions or concerns regarding the Health Check, please visit the Medical Service Center beforehand.

(10) Publication of a "Certificate of Health" for Employment : The self-operated publication of a "Certificate of Health" is scheduled to begin in early May.

(11) Students of Kinugasa campus are not allowed to undergo the Health Check at different campuses.
