1. Dual Master's Degree Program

Dual Master's Degree Program (DMDP) is an innovative program that allows students to earn two Master's Degrees from two universities in as short as two years by studying at an overseas graduate school for approximately one year while enrolling the Graduate School of Ritsumeikan University.

3. Application

■ Eligibility

- 1. To fulfill language requirements of the host university you wish to apply
- 2. To be able to present a research plan in English at an interview
- 3. To have fundamental knowledge of international relations

Eligibility might become flexible to an extent depending on a partnership university's policy, etc. If you are interested in applying but do not meet some requirements, please consult with the Administrative Office in advance.

■ Required Documents

- 1. DMDP application form with your academic advisor's comment (prescribed): the form can be downloaded from DMDP website.
- 2. Research Plan written in both English (of approximately 500 words) and Japanese (of approximately 1,000 letters)
 - *A4 size, free format
 - *Submission of research plan written in Japanese is not mandatory for students in English-based programs.
- 3. An official score report of the TOEFL® IELTS (A photocopy is acceptable; TOEFL®-ITP is unacceptable).
 - *This is applicable to those whose mother tongue is not English.
 - *Those who wish to apply for an U.K university, IELTS score is required.
 - *Scores over two years old are invalid.
