

<Special Considerations for Class in relation to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19)>

1. In order to prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), students who are absent from class due to the following reasons will be given special consideration as a temporary measure.

- ① If you have been infected with COVID-19.
- ② If you are instructed to stay home by public healthcare centers or medical institutions, etc. because you have been in close contact with someone infected with COVID-19.
- ③ If you have the symptom such as fever, shortness of breath (respiratory difficulties) or a strong sense of fatigue (weariness).

Because such an absence is different from “official absence,” the absence is counted as non-attendance. However, please apply for special considerations for class. Instructors shall do the following as far as possible, so that the student can smoothly learn what they should study.

- [Examples of the Support Concerning Classes]
- Provide the student with any materials distributed during class
 - Indicate the material covered during class and explain the key points
 - Provide guidance for self-study
 - Provide other guidance and/or assistance regarding the class, including alternatives for the tests or reports given during the class.

*As for non-attendance because of the above cases, the university has asked instructors to make sure that such non-attendance does not cause disadvantages in grading, in addition to the above arrangements.

*If there is anything that needs to be confirmed in the application, the faculty members in charge may ask the student to submit an official certificate such as a medical certificate, etc.

2. How to apply

Application Period for fall semester courses:

From 9:00 am (JST) Monday, September 27 to 5:00 pm (JST) Monday, January 31

In order to promptly notify to instructors in charge of the courses, please apply immediately once the period of absence is confirmed.
