Syllabus Search

You can search for a syllabus by using the "Syllabus Search" in the "manaba+R My Page."

1. Quick Search

You can do a quick search by typing the course code, course title, instructor or other keywords into the text box under "Syllabus Search".



Type the course code,
course title, instructor,
etc. then click .

2. Advanced Search

By using "Advanced Search", you can search not only by keywords but also conditions such as the academic year/semester, day of week, etc. You can also search for syllabi from the past 4 years. Specify the keywords and conditions, then click [Search].
