

#### "Quest for truth"

Research is the practice of building on past achievements and further developing newly discovered knowledge for all humanity.



#### Critical point for researchers to remember

To understand the rules of research

Research ethics is an important element of the rules.

- Compliance with laws and regulations



#### Case of research misconduct

Case of research misconduct: The Schön Scandal (2002)

#### Hendrik Schön

Hired by Bell Labs as a contract researcher after receiving his doctoral degree from the University of Konstanz. 1998:

2000: His research paper was published in *Nature* when he was 29.

Suspected of having fabricated his experimental data

2002: Schön was found to have committed research misconduct.

An investigation determined that he was guilty of research misconduct (fabrication and falsification) and his doctoral degree was revoked.

#### Reasons for learning research ethics

 To be treated as a researcher with the ability to conduct research on your own judgment

To accomplish your research

(3) Presentation of research results


