In this research, the objects of study are "Johnny's" fans born in and currently living in Mainland China. Chinese "Johnny's" fans support the "Johnny's" idols from Japan through various means—even though the political situation between China and Japan is strained. According to the results of questionnaires and personal interviews, it can be summarized that there is a commonality in the behavior patterns among Chinese "Johnny's" fans. Usually, "Johnny's" fans have something in common that causes them to be attracted to one certain idol or idol group. In that way, they begin to take part in regular activities involving the idols that they like. Such activities have brought these fans together, and the impact of these activities strengthened the attractiveness of certain idols or idol groups.
