Abstract

Himote means the man who expresses sexual frustrations such as not having a girlfriend. This study finds out what distresses Himotes by interviewing them in a group talk for men. The analysis of their interviews by Modified Grounded Theory Approach show the following. Himotes think that they are inferior to and alienated in the surrounding people. They are abused in their home and work place, school. In such a situation, they meet women who take kindly to them and worship them, and think that they can recover from this unfortunate situation by going about her. Himotes make their moves on women while referring to animations and comics, but not considering her feelings. Their moves become extremely gradual. Himotes hold self-abnegation because they repeat stalking acts such as hankering after women and are refused by them. From the above-mentioned analysis, this study reveals that the suffering Himotes hold is not simply sexual frustrations, but a series of processes that feeling in inferior and a sense of estrangement through damaged experiences, and deeply attaching to a woman while being affected by the media, strongly deny themselves from a sense of guilt of their act and failure of being refused by her.
