2. Qualification requirements

Graduate students who are currently enrolled in doctoral programs in the science fields (ex, Science and engineering, Information science and engineering, Life sciences, Sports and health science) or will enter to these doctoral programs from next April.

4) In case of too many applications, we will choose presenters based on the application forms and send the results by e-mail.
