About Tongji University

Tongji University, one of China’s earliest national key universities, is a prestigious institution of higher education which is directly under the Ministry of Education (MOE) and is supported by the Shanghai Municipality. Already in its second centenary, the University has grown into a comprehensive and research-intensive university with distinctive features and an international reputation. According to 2019 Global Universities Rankings by US News & World Report, Tongji University ranks 11th in Country Rank of China and 35th in Best Global Universities in Asia.

Tongji University has established 29 schools/colleges and 10 academic disciplines of engineering, science, medicine, management, economics, philosophy, humanities, law, education, and arts. Currently, there are 18,116 full-time registered Bachelor’s students, 12,105 registered Master’s students, 5,766 registered Doctoral students, and 3,575 international students. Tongji has always placed nurturing talents of the highest quality as its fundamental responsibility. The three-dimensional KAP educational principles of “Knowledge, Ability, and Personality” are deeply rooted in the undergraduate education and reinforced at the graduate level of education, aiming to ensure that every student has “a solid foundation, practical ability, creativity, global vision, and a sense of social responsibility” in order to become “the top talent who will lead sustainable development and act as the backbone of society.” Among over 360,000 graduates of the University since its founding, many are extraordinary political leaders, scientists, educators, social activists, business leaders, medical specialists, and engineering experts. Over 166 alumni are members of the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the Chinese Academy of Engineering.

So far, Tongji University has established 11 international cooperation platforms in partnership with Germany, France, Italy, Finland, Spain and United Nations agencies. The University has also signed memorandum of understanding with over 200 international universities and co-founded research centers with Volkswagen, Siemens, Bayer, IBM and many other multinational enterprises.



Program Features

1. Chinese courses are delivered via live stream that might provide you a real-time interaction with teachers and a vigorous atmosphere of class teaching;
2. Chinese graduate students will help you learn Chinese after class and communicate with you;
3. We offer substantial online cultural lectures, you can watch them on your own convenience.
4. You will have an online tour to Tongji University and learn about China and Shanghai from multiple perspectives;
5. Electronic certificate of completion will be offered to students who completed the program and homework.

Students can choose to attend either the morning class (9:00-11:00 Beijing time) or the afternoon class (15:00-17:00 Beijing time) of Chinese course, because the teaching content will be the same. For the rest of the recorded broadcast courses, students can log in the website to arrange the study time by themselves, but they must complete the corresponding study tasks and submit the assignments within the specified study time.

Instructional platform

Platform like Chinese Bridge Delegation Online, VooV meeting and WeChat will be used.

Note: The usage of all these platforms will be described in the "Study Manual" which you will receive before the start of the camp.

Courses Introduction

1. Opening ceremony, lecture about exchange at Tongji University and orientation course

Opening ceremony: introduction to the Winter Camp and teachers and teaching assistant; Brief introduction to Tongji University and its major settings; Orientation course: an oral Chinese proficiency tests for new students will be conducted according to the classes that are divided before the camp. Then, teachers and assistant might adjust class accordingly, also establish class chat groups and distribute relevant study materials.

2. Chinese Course (Live)

Considering that students should enjoy more practical opportunities to use Chinese while studying online, the course will consist of two parts: "comprehensive course" and "practice course". This program is planned to be taught in small classes, with no more than 20 students in each class. Students will be divided into different class according to their Chinese language proficiency, and attend various courses. After class, we can arrange teaching assistants to help international students practice Chinese so as to create an "immersive" language environment according to your needs.

3. Cultural Courses(Prerecorded Lectures)

Lesson 1: Chinese traditional clothing

Students will discern Han Chinese clothing and enjoy traditional Chinese costume performances.

Lesson 2: Chinese Cuisine

Students will learn about Chinese food culture and eight regional cuisines, and learn to make Chinese dish and traditional Chinese dim sum.

Lesson 3: The Belt and Road Initiative and Chinese Culture Broadcast

With the introduction point of the Belt and Road fever title, combined with the current development status of the international community, the background and practical significance of the construction of the Belt and Road are told, and the relationship with the development of Chinese culture is deepened, and the trainees are guided to pay attention to and spread the Chinese story.

Lesson 4: The spread and influence of Chinese characters in Japan

After the ancient Chinese characters were transmitted to Japan, they had a positive impact on the social development and cultural prosperity of Japan. The "Japanese Chinese" created by the Japanese in modern times has also played a great role in the development of Chinese culture.

Lesson 5: Tips for preparing for the HSK test

Introduce the basic situation and requirements of the HSK test, teach test-taking skills, and enhance students' confidence in taking the test.

4. An Online Trip to Shanghai & Tongji (live)

The "Panda Daodao" program (international students team) from the International School of Tongji University was invited to go sightseeing in Shanghai with the students and share their perspectives about China and the city. Visiting landmark buildings in Tongji and some of its special colleges such as College of Architecture and Urban Planning, College of Design and Innovation, and College of Ocean and Earth Science.

Who can apply?

This program is open to 16-year-old or above non-Chinese citizens, including students, faculty members and staff from the cooperative schools of Tongji University, and students who are interested in studying with Tongji University.
