< Troubleshooting-Solutions: Mac>

If the TOEFL Audio Browser is not working well during the test, try the following solutions first. The suspended time will not count toward the test duration, so please relax and take your time.

Before you start the listening section, you can't hear the sound in the audio check.

- If the TOEFL Audio Browser doesn't work properly such as: the question isn't showing.
- The error message appears.
- The screen freezes.

Suddenly, the TOEFL Secure Browser shut down.

A computer freezes. (A computer doesn't work at all.)

The test is in a paused state.

Ctrl + Shift + Q

Pause the test and close the TOEFL Audio Browser.

command+option+Shift+Q

Do the same as you logged in before.
