

Research Proposal Contest Entry Guidelines~Communicating your research to others~

“Research Proposal Contest” is a contest on “How to make the idea real” and “How to write the research plan more attractive”. This contest is held once a year since 2013 with the same contents of JSPS application on the purpose of being selected as Research Fellowship for Young Scientists.

Those who apply for Research Proposal Contest can get the examination result with the review comments of examiners. For those who have applied for JSPS Research Fellowship for Young Scientists before are encouraged to use this chance for brush up. For those who plan to apply for JSPS are motivated to utilize this for practice. The winners will receive prizes, and Grand Prize Winner will get a chance to present his/her research at Rice Ball Seminar to accumulate his/her achievement.

Those who don't aim to be Research Fellowship for Young Scientists are also encouraged to entry this contest positively to get the feedback on how to write their research plan and have a chance to present their researches. For all graduate students, would you like to try writing your research plan and get an evaluation on your plan by others? We are looking forward to your entry!

To prepare for the JSPS Research Fellowship for Young Scientists application

The content and format of the application form for this research proposal contest is almost the same as that of JSPS (JSPS Research Fellowship for Young Scientists). JSPS accepts applications every year. Therefore, this annual research proposal contest could be considered as a training before applying for JSPS. We expect applicants of the research proposal contest to proactively apply to the JSPS after this contest and being selected as JSPS.

Objective

- (1) To improve conception ability for research.
- (2) To develop your ability to convey your specialist knowledge and research results to wider society.
- (3) To improve your generic writing ability.

Qualification Requirements

Graduate students who are currently enrolled in regular programs at Ritsumeikan University are eligible to apply(Those who are taking leave of absence cannot apply).

Application Guidelines

Application

- (1) Only one application per person is accepted. (Joint research is not accepted.)
- (2) Applications must be made by the applicants.
- (3) Applicants who have applied before cannot apply with the same research proposal. The contents this time must be improved by reflecting the research progress and status until now.
- (4) Entry Form submitted will not be returned. Please ensure that you make copies of all documents by yourself.
- (5) Applications that do not meet the requirements or do not abide by the rules for submission will be excluded.
- (6) If any falsehood of research progress or results is found on the application, the applicant will be severely punished in accordance with Ritsumeikan University Student Disciplinary Regulations.
- (7) We cannot answer queries regarding screening process.
- (8) Please contact the Office of Graduate Studies if you have a visual or hearing disability and have difficulty in indicating by figures.

How to create Entry Form

- (1) Download the Entry Form from the website of the Graduate Students Career Path Support Center. Please make sure to create your Entry Form by using the prescribed form for this contest and type. If you change the prescribed format or if you attach documents composed on paper other than the prescribed form,

your application will not be accepted.

- (2) Use diagrams (graphs, charts or other methods) and colors which are easy to identify to provide a general outline of your research in “1. Research outline diagram” box (Page 2 of the Entry Form).

- (3) Create your Entry Form by using a computer.
- (4) Entry Form should be written in Japanese or English.
- (5) Use graphs, charts, or other visual aids to make your research proposal understandable to readers, who may not necessarily be experts in, nor have previous knowledge of, your field. Do not use abbreviations.
- (6) The Entry Form must be submitted in PDF format.

Evaluation

Criteria

The following 7 examination items will be examined from the perspectives of examination criteria ① Consistency of argument and format, ② Readability and clarity of explanation, ③ Creativity, ④ Concreteness of research plan/proposal, and ⑤ Ability to execute research.

- (1) Research outline diagram

Whether Research outline diagram keeps the main points of the proposal and explains the content clearly and attractively.

- (2) Research background

Whether research background is explained with references based on the research situation so far, whether the argument and format are consistent.

- (3) Research objectives/contents

Whether the objectives of the research are concretely and clearly indicated, whether methods and plans for achieving the research objectives are well thought-out, whether the argument and format are consistent and intellectually suggestive.

- (4) Unique/creative features of the research

Whether the perspective of setting research topics are distinctive and inventive, whether there will be expected impact and future prospects when the research is completed, whether the argument and format are consistent and intellectually suggestive.

- (5) Research Plan

Research Plan from now till the applicant will complete his/her program will be evaluated in consideration

of applicants' courses and grades.

(6) Ability to execute research

The basis of explaining the research tasks feasibility will be evaluated in consideration of applicants' courses and grades.

(7) Motivation for becoming a researcher, intended image of a researcher in the future, strength points.

Evaluate applicant's motivation for becoming a researcher, intended image of a researcher and his/her strength points.

Examination Method

(1) Entry Forms will be examined by a screening committee established by the Graduate Student Career Path Support Center.

(2) If any falsehood of research progress or results is found on the application, the applicant will be severely punished in accordance with Ritsumeikan University Student Disciplinary Regulations.

[Handling of Personal Information]

Personal information obtained by the contest organizer as part of the Ritsumeikan University Graduate School Research Proposal Contest will be managed and handled in accordance with the Ritsumeikan Trust Basic Policy for the Protection of Personal Information. However, names, affiliations and research outline diagram of awardees will be posted at the awards ceremony and on the Ritsumeikan websites.

Past applicants adopted

Among 118 applicants for this contest over the past five years, a total of 17 have of them have been accepted as Research Fellowships for Young Scientists.

To apply for JSPS Research Fellowships for Young Scientists

We hope graduate students to proactively apply to the JSPS Research Fellowship for Young Scientists, which starts calling for applicants around May every year. Graduate Student Career Path Support Center provides support for students who are applying for JSPS Research Fellowships for Young Scientists as follows.
