Peter Adey is Professor of Human Geography at Royal Holloway University of London and is well known within the field of mobility studies. He is a coeditor of the journal Mobilities, and the author of several books and various paper articles, including the forthcoming edited collection the Encyclopedia of Mobilities (eds with Kaya Barry and Weiqiang Lin) and the book, Evacuation: emergency politics and the aesthetics of mobility (in press with Duke University Press). Other works include Aerial Life: mobilities, subjects, affects (2010) and Mobility (2009; 2017 2nd edition). He is also a co-investigator at the Academy of Mobility Humanities at Konkuk University, Seoul.
