What is “collage tanka” ?

It is a genre of playful poetry making practice, where you cut out words and phrases from pages of newspaper and advertisements and combine them to create tanka poetry (with 31 syllables).

Using “found” words instead of your own can lead to an opportunity to create an unexpected piece of work.

What is “fake it till you make it” ?

It is a name we’ve given to creative experiments to produce something new through imitation. Copying the work of someone with respect enables us to deeply understand the work and the artist as well as broadening our mind!
