Instruction manual for TOEFL ITP® test (For Windows)
~On the Test Day~

Updated: March 2026

*Important: All times referenced in this manual are in Japan Standard Time (JST).

This manual is about the flow of TOEFL ITP® test (Digital) on the day of the test. Please read this manual before taking the test. **Please print it out before taking the test as you will not be able to view it on your computer during the test.**

On the day of the test

1. Verify the environment to take the test

Prohibited Acts

- ◆ You cannot take the test at the public place such as a café.
- ◆ Take the test at the quiet and isolated place with sufficient brightness.
Be careful not to let the other person come near.
- ◆ No food or drink during the test.
- ◆ You cannot leave in the middle of the test. ※Please go to the bathroom before you start the test.
- ◆ Do not place books, smart watches, tablets, smart phones (only for emergency use allowed), electronic dictionaries, or other electronic devices on or around your desk.

If you do not follow the above instructions, you will be asked to stop the test and will not get the score. If the administration of the test suspects that you to cheat on the test or you do not follow the instructions, they have the right to request ETS to stop scoring.

Note

- ◆ You may take notes during the test. (Have a pen and a memo ready)
*Please be sure to destroy or delete any notes taken during the test after the test is completed.
If the contents of the test are leaked as a result of this, you will be subject to punishment.
- ◆ Please take the test using the PC and Internet environment that you have confirmed in the prior preparation work.
*If you use the mobile Wi-Fi router, please disconnect the other Electric devices because the transmission speed might be slow. It may cause losing the internet connection in the middle of the test.
- ◆ Close all apps before you start the test.
- ◆ Be sure to connect earphones or headphones to your PC before launching the TOEFL Secure Browser.
Verify if the audio is output normally.
- ◆ If PC audio is muted, you will not hear sounds. Please be sure to unmute PC.
- ◆ You can print out the score. Please have the printer ready if you wish to print it.
- ◆ Please take a note of Session Number. * You will need to enter it when you log in.
Session Numbers will be posted on the website at 9:30 a.m. on the day of the test.
- ◆ Please keep the AC adaptor connected to your PC to ensure the PC remains powered on.

- ◆ In case of any PC problems (such as login trouble or being unable to open the app), please contact Help desk.
- ◆ In case of any PC problems during the test, please try to solve the issues according to page 6 of [Troubleshooting-Solutions ~On Test Day~]. If the issues remain unresolved, please contact Help desk. Leaving the PC troubles unresolved will be considered as withdrawing from the tests.

2. From the start to the end of the test

- ▶ **Please close all apps except the TOEFL Secure Browser.**
- ▶ **Please connect earphones or the headphones to your PC first.**

① Launch the TOEFL Secure Browser

② Click **[Start My Classroom Test]**

Please select **"Start my Classroom Test"**
 Do not select **"Start My At Home Test"**

③ Enter Session Number and click **[Submit]** *Enter **half-width numbers including the hyphen(-)**.

Session Numbers will be available **on the English Placement Test at 9:30 a.m. on the day of the test.**

④ Enter **Student ID (10 digits : 26+your Examination Number)** and **Family name** on the right side of the screen. Then, click **[Submit]** *Your examination number is written on your examination voucher or acceptance letter.
*Please do not enter your Middle name in the Family Name fields.

 Click **[Submit]**
Do not enter anything on the left side.

- ⑤ If Student Confirmation displayed on the screen is correct, click **[Yes]**

*If you receive an error message that the information you entered is incorrect, the spelling of your name or Student ID may be incorrect. Please check your pre-registered information and re-enter it again on the screen of instruction ④.

*When it is time to start the test, the proctor will allow you to begin the test. It may take 4-5 minutes to be approved, however, please relax and wait for a moment, as the test duration will not be shortened.

*If more than 30 minutes pass on this screen, you will need to submit your request again.

**★You can apply for the test 15 minutes before the test starts.
You may begin the test as soon as you are allowed.**

- ⑦ Once you are allowed, you will automatically be take to the test start screen.

*Please follow the instructions below to proceed.

- ① Your Profile screen→ Answered the questionnaire about studying English, then click **[Save]** .
- ② Explanation for Copyright→ Click **[NEXT]**.
- ③ Confidentiality Agreement Yes/No →Select **[Yes]**.
- ④ General Direction
- ⑤ Headset wearing confirmation screen (The message, "Put on your headset", will appears)
→Click **[NEXT]**. You will not hear the audio until you click **[Next]**.
→Please adjust the volume.
- ⑥ Checking Microphone screen (only for those taking the Speaking section)
→Record your voice by reading the sentences on the screen. Check if the audio is clear.

※If you cannot hear the audio in ⑤ or ⑥ above, do not start the test.

In that case, please contact Help Desk.

From the beginning of the test to the end, the proctor will be monitoring the progress of the test constantly. The proctor may pause the test without your consent and contact you in the following case.

- In case that unusual progress is observed.
- In case that the proctor suspects the act of dishonest or cheating.

Important instructions during the test

- This test has a time limit. Please check the timer displayed on the upper right corner of the screen during the test.
- As for Section 2 and 3, you can add a check mark to review your answer afterwards by clicking **[Mark for Review]** at the bottom left of the screen.
- If you complete the test within the time limit, you can review and modify your answers from **[Review]** at the bottom right of the screen.
- Even if there is still time left for Section 2, you can move to Section 3. However, you cannot go back to the previous section.
- In Section 2 and 3, the timer becomes yellow 5 minutes before the end, and an alert appears. When time is up, the section will be automatically terminated.
- During the speaking section, try to speak loud and clearly. The score of speaking section will be judged by AI, so if your voice is not clear enough you may not receive a score.



How to troubleshoot problems during test testing

※ It is illustrated in a chart on p. 6.

- During the test, if the screen freezes, behaves strangely, or displays any message on the screen, Press **Ctrl** + **Shift** + **Q** to pause the test and close the Secure Browser. (If a message appears on the test screen and you press OK, the Secure Browser will close automatically.)
- If your PC freezes and does not work during the test, Press **Ctrl** + **Alt** + **Delete** to restart the PC.
- In the above cases, or if the Secure Browser unexpectedly closes during the test, you will be returned to the desktop screen, so double-click the "TOEFL Secure Browser" in the download folder again without any security software or other applications or software running. Once the Secure Browser opens, enter your Session Number, personal information, and wait for a moment until the proctor allows you to take the test.

Once approved, the test will restart from where it stopped.

The suspended time will not count toward the test duration, so please relax and take your time.

At the end of the test

After the test is completed, the score screen will appear.

The [Print] and [Exit] buttons are located in the lower right corner of the score screen.

cf. Please note that you will not be able to go back to the score screen after clicking [Exit].

*Your speaking score may not be displayed depending on the grading status. You will be notified of your score by the university in April, regardless of whether it is displayed (see ★ below for details).

■ If you want to keep score

To print, click [Print] and print out a copy. You can also take a picture of the screen and save it.

※In case that PC freezes while printing out the score report

If the score report is displayed, the test has been successfully completed.

However, you will not be able to go back to the printing screen even if you log in again.

★You will receive your score in your personal notification on RITSUMEIKAN STUDENT PORTAL in early April.

Score reports will also be distributed at a later date.

The date and place of distribution are described in RITSUMEIKAN STUDENT PORTAL.

Please be sure to destroy or delete any notes taken during the test after the test is completed.
If the contents of the test are leaked as a result of this, you will be subject to punishment.



If the TOEFL Secure Browser is not working well during the test, try the following solutions first. The suspended time will not count toward the test duration, so please relax and take your time.



If you cannot resume the test with the troubleshooting-solutions above, please contact Language Education Center (Osaka Ibaraki Campus).

In case of the following situation, the proctor may pause the test.

- The proctor suspects the act of cheating.
- The progress status of the test does not change at all.

*When the proctor pauses the test, the message below will appear. In that case, Click OK. Contact the Helpdesk.
