1. Course Period

August 1 (Thu) - August 5 (Mon), 2024 *Classes held on Saturday and Sunday

The Course Period partially overlaps with Ritsumeikan University's Final Examination (Makeup Examination)

Schedule. Please note that no special consideration will be provided for students who are unable to take examinations/makeup examinations due to its scheduling conflict with the summer session.

2. Applicable Course

1 Course (2 credits)

* You may select up to your second choice of course when applying. If the first choice has more than expected applicants, you may be able to take your second choice.

3. Credit Limit

Summer Session course credits are not included in the Annual Course Credit Limit of each college.

Those subject to "Conditions Pertaining to Tuition Payable by Students Whose Total Enrollment Period Exceeds the Standard Enrollment Period" stated in the Academic Handbook, a course you register for APU summer session will be included in the number of credits registered for the spring semester. 4. Number of Students

Maximum Total Acceptances: 100 (with a limited number of accepted students per course) For each course capacity, please see '8. Course List'.

5. Eligibility Applicant

An applicant must:

• Be Undergraduate students enrolled in the following colleges

College of Law, College of Social Sciences, College of International Relations (excluding Joint Degree Program), College of Letters, College of Economics, College of Science and Engineering (excluding students who were enrolled to the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering in AY2018-2021), College of Life Sciences, College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, College of Sport and Health Science, College of Business Administration, College of Policy Science, and College of Comprehensive Psychology, College of Image Arts and Sciences

- Be Undergraduate students whose registry status is "Enrolled" or "Study Abroad".
- · Have completed at least one year of study at an undergraduate program by the time of starting the program.
 - *Students who are expected to graduate at the end of this spring semester cannot apply for the summer session.

 - *Students who have not previously participated will be given priority.

<Notes for Online Application Process>

- 1. You may apply as many times as you want during the application period. However, it is important to note that the latest submitted application will be considered as the official application, thus the information from previous applications will be deleted.
- 2. Click 'Proceed to Application Confirmation (申請内容画面へ進む) 'button to confirm your input information. If the information is correct, please print the page and keep it with you. After printing out, click 'Submit (申請内容提出) 'to complete your application.
- 3. Once the application is complete, you will see the message as 'Your application has been accepted' on the screen. If the message has not appeared, your application submission has failed.
- 4. After logging in, if there is no activity for more than 30 minutes, the screen will automatically return to the login page. Please be aware that any entries made prior to that time will not be saved either.
