1. Missions

2. Activity conditions

- (2) Place of activity: Held mainly in and around the BBP on the respective campus and online (via Zoom).

3. Number of candidates sought

Approximately 35 persons per campus

4. Application conditions

- (1) Persons interested in international exchange and the university's internationalization, who can participate with enthusiasm in the activities of the BBP.
- (2) Students from colleges or graduate schools on the respective campus, or semester-based exchange students (such as SKP students) enrolled in the Spring semester 2025 as their second semester, are eligible to apply. All nationals are welcome.
- (3) 【Japanese language based students】 The ability to hold an everyday conversation in English is desirable.
- (4) [English language based students] The ability to hold an everyday conversation in Japanese is desirable.
- (5) Must be able to participate in the start-up training session. (Refer to the schedules below.)

5. Screening and Notification of Selection

The screening process will be based on the application documents. Applicants who pass the initial screening will be invited to a face-to-face interview. The interview schedule and screening results will be announced on manaba+R. (Refer to the schedules below.)

The meeting will be conducted in hybrid (face-to-face at the BBP and via Zoom).
