Beyond Borders Plaza (BBP) was launched as a place where students from diverse nationalities, languages, and backgrounds can meet and learn from each other. We are now recruiting members to join the “BBP Project Team” (extracurricular activities group) for activities in the Spring Semester 2026.

“BBP Project Team” will be responsible for planning and organizing activities and events that respond to the interests of students who want to meet diverse people, are interested in studying abroad or wish to try it, and who aim to improve and make use of their language skills. If you’re interested, we encourage you to apply actively!

1. Objectives of Activities

- (1) To raise awareness of BBP among students and create a more welcoming and accessible space.
- (2) To implement projects that promote communication and learning across national and language barriers.
- (3) To organize activities and events that meet the needs of students interested in themes like studying abroad or language improvement.

2. Activity Conditions

- (1) Activity Period: April 1, 2026 (Wed) – July 16, 2026 (Thu)

Team members are expected to engage in planning and preparation about twice a week.

- (2) Activity Location: Mainly at the BBP on your campus.

4. Eligibility

- (1) Students who are interested in international exchange and the internationalization of the university and who can participate enthusiastically in BBP activities.
- (2) Regular students enrolled in undergraduate or graduate schools on their campuses, or short-term students such as SKP students, who will be in their second semester in Fall 2025. Nationality does not matter.
- (3) [For Japanese-medium students] English skills for daily conversation are preferred.
- (4) [For English-medium students] Japanese skills for daily conversation are preferred.
- (5) **Be able to participate in training sessions.**
※Those also applying for BBP Management Staff must attend both the Project Team and Management Staff training sessions.

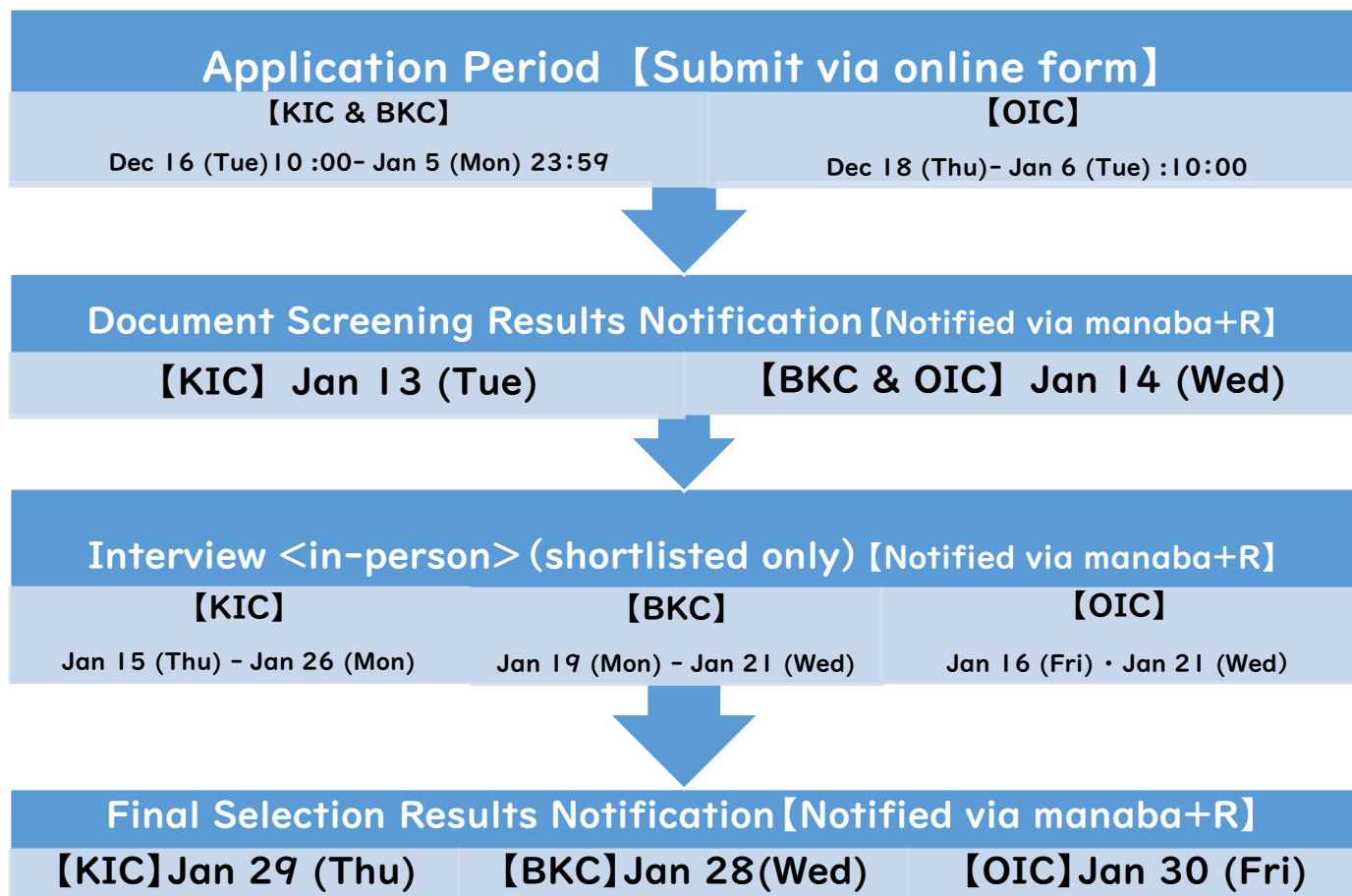
