Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (APU) was established in 2000 in Beppu City, Oita Prefecture, with the cooperation of the Ritsumeikan Trust, Oita Prefecture, and Beppu City. APU's graduate schools include the Graduate School of Asia Pacific Studies (GSA) and the Graduate School of Management (GSM), both of which offer programs entirely in English. Additionally, APU's graduate schools host a diverse student body, as well as faculty, with half of the faculty coming from overseas. Furthermore, APU has received accreditation from multiple international organizations, including AACSB and AMBA. The value of its programs is recognized not only by the Japanese government but also by various external organizations such as the Asian Development Bank and the African Development Bank, which offer prestigious scholarships. APU provides an environment where students from around the world can develop intercultural communication skills and a global perspective while learning from each other.
