- Undergraduate student in College of Law, College of Social Sciences, College of International Relations (excluding Joint Degree Program), College of Letters, College of Economics, College of Science and Engineering (excluding Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering AY2018-2021 enrollees), College of Sport and Health Science, College of Life Sciences, College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, College of Business Administration, College of Policy Science or College of Comprehensive Psychology.
- Applicants must have completed at least one year of study at an undergraduate school prior to the start of the program. However, Applicants in their last two semesters of undergraduate study are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants must have earned at least 16 credits per semester by the time of application.
- Applicants must have completed all of the courses (such as foreign language courses) required for graduation and designated by their college that are offered up to the time of application.
- Applicants who have already participated in this program are not eligible to apply.
