Editorial Committee

- **Eligibility:** Professors, lecturers, and researchers of Ritsumeikan University; Visiting Collaborative Researchers at the International Institute of Language and Culture Studies, Ritsumeikan University; those invited to contribute by the Editorial Committee; and those approved to submit by the Editorial Committee.
- **Topics:** The paper should be written on a topic which pertains to the research areas of the International Institute of Language and Culture Studies.
- **Category:** Articles, Short Research Reports, Translations, Introductions of Archived Documents, and manuscripts solicited or approved by the Editorial Committee.

➤ **The steps from application to publication**

1. Until the decision on whether the manuscript may be submitted
 - (1) Authors: Please prepare an application form, an abstract in Japanese or English, and keywords in Japanese and English. Submit these to the Secretariat of the International Institute of Language and Culture Studies (hereinafter referred to as the “Secretariat”).
 - (2) Editorial Committee: Based on the above application form, the Editorial Committee deliberates and decides whether or not to accept the manuscript.
 - (3) Secretariat: Based on that decision, the Secretariat notifies authors whether or not they may submit their manuscripts.
2. If the Editorial Committee determines that the manuscript may be submitted:
 - (1) Authors: Submit manuscript data (both Word and PDF data) to the secretariat by the deadline.
 - (2) Peer review: Peer review is conducted by reviewers requested by the Editorial Committee and the Secretariat.
 - (3) Editorial Committee: Based on the results of peer review, the Editorial Committee deliberates and decides whether to accept or reject the manuscript for publication.

➤ **matters that require attention**

- Before submitting your application, please make sure to read the “Guidelines for Contributors” and the “Regulations for Contributors” for Ritsumeikan Studies in Language and Culture.
- The abstract must be in Japanese or English, and the keywords must be in both Japanese and English. Submit them on a single sheet of A4 paper (any format) together with the application form (available on the Institute's website).
- The deadline for submission of manuscripts for Volume 38, Issue 3 is October 19, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.
- When submitting a manuscript, in addition to the main text, authors must attach an abstract (if the main text is in Japanese, an abstract in English of no more than 150 words; if the main text is in another language, an abstract in Japanese of no more than 430 characters) and keywords in both Japanese and English (up to five).
- The issue may be changed depending on the date of submission of the author's manuscript.
- In the printed version of the journal, color figures will be displayed in black and white, while the repository version will be in color.

- As a general rule, each author may submit only one individual paper per issue. Exceptions may be approved by the Editorial Committee upon review.
- Submission of individual papers by the same author in consecutive issues is, in principle, not allowed in order to provide more people with the opportunity to contribute. Exceptions may be approved by the Editorial Committee upon review.

➤ **Application Deadline and Submission**

- Deadline: **August 31, 2026, at 12:00 p.m**
