

Violence and Gun Society


 United Health Care CEO Brian Thompson was shot and killed in 2024.

• In 2023, there were 546,159 victims of child abuse and neglect. The victim rate is 7.4 victims per 1,000 children in the population.

Lack of Support and Understanding of Mental Illness

 Arizona's massive cuts to the Mental health budget (2009-2011)

More than 10,000 patients lost support.

Many people were unable to receive treatments, leading to an increase in homelessness, emergency transports, and arrests.

 In the 2026 budget proposal, the funding for the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) was cut by 21%.

E.g., the elimination of programs providing community-based intensive care for people with severe mental illnesses.


