

Free article processing charge in Cambridge University Press journals

【Feature】

- If the first author is a member of Ritsumeikan University, the APC required for open access will be free.
- 337 journals (as of October 30, 2019) in a wide range of academic fields from natural sciences to the humanities and social sciences published by CUP are eligible for APC free (The title list can be downloaded from the following URL.)
- The average APC for 337 journals is £ 1820 per article, but they are free.
- During the contract period from January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2022, APC is unlimited and free.
- In order to make an article open access, the first author belonging to Ritsumeikan University needs to perform procedures in the CUP system.

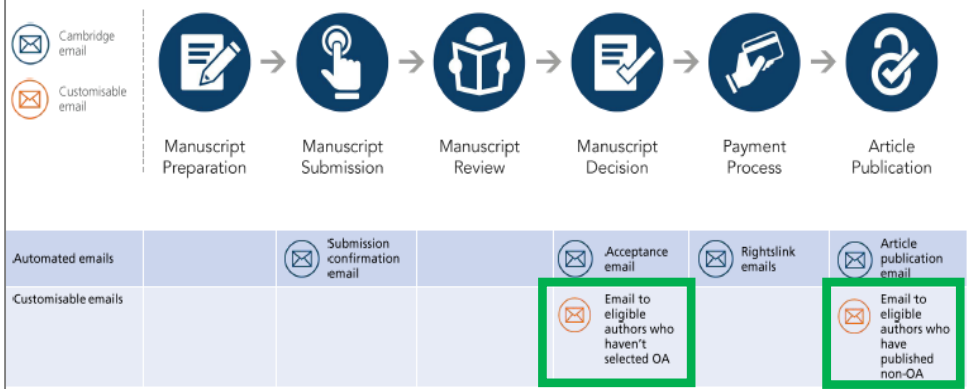


【CUP system procedures (overview)】

In order to submit an article as the lead author, you must first create a CUP system account.

Whether you belong to Ritsumeikan University (whether it is eligible for free) is determined by the profile information (email address domain, institution name, ORCID, etc.) registered in your account. Please register your email address provided by Ritsumeikan University.

After registering your profile, a message will appear on the system stating that you can open access your article for free.
