Gendered Transformations under the Pandemic in East Asia

Coordinators and Moderators







What kind of gendered impacts and political, economic and social transformations has the Covid-19 pandemic brought about in East Asia? What kind of challenges and possibilities do these transformations pose for democracy and social justice in the region? This forum aims at creating a space for dialogues and collective knowledge production among activists and researchers from feminist perspectives that focus on intersections of gender and other social elements.

While East Asian countries are largely regarded as being successful so far in preventing the widespread of Covid-19, there have been relatively few opportunities for international exchange of feminist analysis, partly because of language barriers. The forum will be composed of a series of dialogue sessions. The first dialogue session will reflect on major gendered impacts and responses of social movements, and attempt to identify emerging challenges, with the participation of feminist activists in the region. The second session will specifically focus on the issues related to social reproduction, neoliberal economy, and gender orders, with participation of feminist researchers exploring transformations in care, migration

The forum will be organized by Ritsumeikan University in Kyoto, Japan, as a part of the Meridian 180 Forum, a global platform to promote crisis preparedness from interdisciplinary perspectives through the multilingual exchange of people in different sectors. Both sessions will be organized as online zoom webinars, with simultaneous interpretation in English, Chinese Mandarin, Korean, and Japanese.
