Administration Policy for Scholarship for Student's Learning and Growth

College of Information Science and Engineering offers the following three scholarships to aim to support student's learning and growth.

1. Saionji Memorial Scholarship (Academically Outstanding Students Category)	
Objectives	In accordance with the objectives of the “Ritsumeikan Model of Learning”, this scholarship aims to reward students who, through hard work, have excelled academically in their curricular studies, and encourage such students to serve as role models for study and further growth among their peers.
Reference year and period on which scholarship selection is based	General students : 1 st year Spring semester to 3 rd year Autumn semester Students that have transferred from DUT : 3 rd year Autumn semester, 3 rd year Spring semester
Eligible students by year and semester	General students : 1 st year Autumn semester to 4 th year Spring semester Students that have transferred from DUT : 3 rd year Spring semester, 4 th year Autumn semester ※Scholarship amounts will be paid to the recipients during the applicable period based on the grade achieved in the preceding semester.
Scholarship amount	300,000 YEN
Selection criteria and method	Selection will be conducted based on the criteria provided in the guidelines.

2. +R College Scholarship	
Objectives	The +R College Scholarship aims to support the study progress of students in College of Information Science and Engineering who have obtained excellent grades in curricular subjects, who possess problem awareness gained through specialized undergraduate study, general education (e.g., teacher training, liberal arts and sciences, foreign language education), study abroad or international study activities, and who develop this awareness with the aim of pursuing specific topics of study. In this way, the scholarship aims to encourage such students to serve as models for learning and growth among their peers.
Eligible students by year	Among second to fourth year students
Scholarship amount	¥50,000 / ¥100,000 / ¥150,000 per student ※The amount of scholarship is determined by the College depending on screening results of achieved outcomes.
Selection criteria and method	Selection will be conducted based on the criteria provided in the guidelines.

3. Learning Community Off-Campus Activity Encouragement Scholarship (For Curricular Classes)	
Objectives	<p>The aim of this scholarship is to encourage any of the learning activities outlined in (1) to (3) below conducted either in groups or at an organizational level as part of curricular classes by providing participating students with part of the cost in the form of a “scholarship” in order to cultivate student learning groups that will independently and actively engage in a range of learning activities.</p> <p>(1) Learning activities for small learning groups</p> <p>(2) Learning activities that harness the characteristics of college education (including online events)</p> <p>(3) Learning activities in the field of teacher education, liberal arts courses, language education and international education</p>
Eligible students by year and semester	All years, All semesters
Scholarship amount	As stated in the guidelines
Application	Faculty members in charge of classes are responsible for submitting the application. (Students are not eligible to apply.)

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
