Laptop Computer Purchase Guide for New Students at the College of International Relations

There will be many occasions that you will need computers in classes and for assignments such as, but not limited to, lectures, presentations, seminars/small-group classes, fieldworks, and data collection/analysis. To make the most of the university education, having a personal device could be beneficial and convenient.

To help you make an informed decision about a purchase, your college has developed the guideline below. While you may opt to have tablet devices, laptop computers with a keyboard and a display are better recommended.

About Necessary Software

Your classes require various software, including, but not limited to, word processing, spreadsheet, and presentation. Ritsumeikan University provides free installation of Office 365 Pro Plus. The software you can install include "Word", "Excel", "PowerPoint", "Access", "Publisher", and "Outlook". Please install these programs by yourself. You will find manuals for these programs through the link below. Please note that as you are only allowed to use Office 365 Pro Plus during the period you are enrolled at Ritsumeikan University, you should install the software after entering the university. Please also note that you can only install the software on your own devices.

[Laptop Computer Functionality (Specification) Check Points]]

- <Weight> You should choose a lightweight and thin model that is easy to carry.
- <Wireless LAN> Wireless LAN can be used in all areas and classrooms at Kinugasa Campus. A network adapter compatible with either IEEE 802.11a, b, g, n, ac, or ax.

Ideally, ax (WiFi 6) or ac (WiFi 5) are best recommended since they have faster transmission speeds.

Use a VPN Connection to Access RAINBOW Outside of Campus
