

RAINBOW ID, Password, and Multi-Factor Authentication

RAINBOW ID (user name) and password are necessary for all students to access university online resources, such as university email, manaba+R (learning management system), GLARS (GLA's course registration system), CAMPUS WEB (student information management system) and Academic Advising Database.

To strengthen its security, the university now requires all students to set multi-factor authentication. Students are responsible for setting multi-factor authentication as soon as they receive the RAINBOW ID and password.

Fall 2026 new students will receive their RAINBOW ID and password via Ritsu-Mate on **September 15 (4 PM in JST)**. Please note that this information will be available on Ritsu-Mate only, not through the GLA Office.
